Community Midwifery Changes, from the 1st of May 2017

At the Royal Berkshire Hospital, we are adopting a new model of working, this is called *The Postnatal Reallocation Model (PRAM)*.

Your midwife will now be working as part of a smaller team, providing a 7day service (8am-4:30pm) to you during and after your pregnancy. Each team will have direct links to a named obstetrician if you require medical support during your pregnancy. Your team will have a *Flower Name*.

You will be allocated a named midwife from the team, but may sometimes need to see another team member if your midwife is away. So no matter the day of the week you will have a midwife to contact.

Working in smaller teams means we can provide you continuity of carer, in a location close to you, and once your baby is born provide you more support and visits at home.
